Sub:- Advisory to all Original Equipment Manufacturers to comply with the directions of Hon'ble Tribunal, Pune in Application No. 39 of 2013 filed by Shri. Dileep B. Nevatia v/s Union of India & Ors.

Madam/Sir,

The Hon'ble Tribunal vide order dated 26.11.2015 has directed this Ministry to issue appropriate notification so that a common purchaser of the vehicle should know before making purchase/s of the vehicle, of various types in order to have comparative understanding and to know the Emission levels in as much as subsequently, an occasion may not arise to improve the equipment to meet further stringent standard, if emission levels are changed.

2. In this regard, all the Original Equipment Manufacturers/Testing Agencies/ State Transport Authorities are advised to undertake the following steps with respect to the compliance of directions issued by Hon'ble NGT, Pune:

With effect from 1st July, 2016, Original Equipment Manufacturers are directed to publish following data for sale of their vehicles, in form of leaflets, to be made available to end purchaser of the vehicles, prior to purchase, at the point of sale:-

1. Mass Emission Values as per Rule 115:

(a) For Petrol/CNG/LPG Vehicles:

3. Noise level as per Rule (2), for all vehicles other than agricultural tractors and construction equipment vehicles:dB(A).
