
Sub: Release of fund to States under CRF for 2019-20 on first-come-first-serve basis –reg.

Sir,

In continuation of this Ministry's letter of even number dated 11/09/2019, I am directed to say that it has been decided with the approval of the competent authority to admit and make release of fund under CRF during 2019-20 (till 31.03.2020) to the concerned States on first-come-first-serve basis so long as release for the State does not exceed the accrual for States and available unspent balance of the State.

2. However, the total sum of release for all the States shall not exceed the total accrual for States for 2019-20, i.e. Rs.6871.49 crore.
3. This issues with the concurrence of Finance Wing vide their U. O. No. 1021 /TF-II/2019-20 dated 05.02.2020.
