## NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 8th August, 2012

**G.S.R. 625(E).**—Whereas the draft of certain rules to amend the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 which were published as required by sub-section (1) of section 212 of the Motor Vehicles Act 1988 (59 of 1988), in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part II, section 3, sub-section (i) dated the 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2011, in the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, number G.S.R. 61 (E), dated the 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2011 inviting objections or suggestions from all persons likely to be affected thereby, before expiry of the period of sixty days from the date on which the copies of the Gazette of India in which the said notification were made available to the public;

And, whereas, copies of the said notification were made available to the public on the 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2011;

And, whereas, objections or suggestions, received from the public in respect of the said draft rules have been considered by the Central Government;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 110 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, namely:-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Central Motor Vehicles (3<sup>rd</sup> Amendment) Rules, 2012.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2 In the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, (hereinafter referred as the said Rules) in rule 93, in sub-rule (6), -

(A) in Explanation I, for clause (c), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:-

“(c) in case of vehicles having more than three axles, and fitted with or without retractable axle, wheelbase shall be the distance measured between the centre of the front-most axle and the centre point of rear combination of non-steered axles.
